Or, students could continue on from yesterday, with another **ASL language learning workshop**, to develop some sign language phrases, hosted by one of our talented students.

Following dinner as usual, the evening’s lecture featured the documentary **‘H is for Harry’**, a coming of age story about Harry, a charismatic 11-year old boy, who arrives at secondary school in suburban London unable to read or write. The students were then treated to a **Q and A** with its director, in which they could find out what Harry is up to now, and learn more about the process of the filmmaking.

But the day was not over yet, with the highly anticipated **World Fair** taking place this evening, giving our students the chance to present to the whole cohort on their country and culture!
